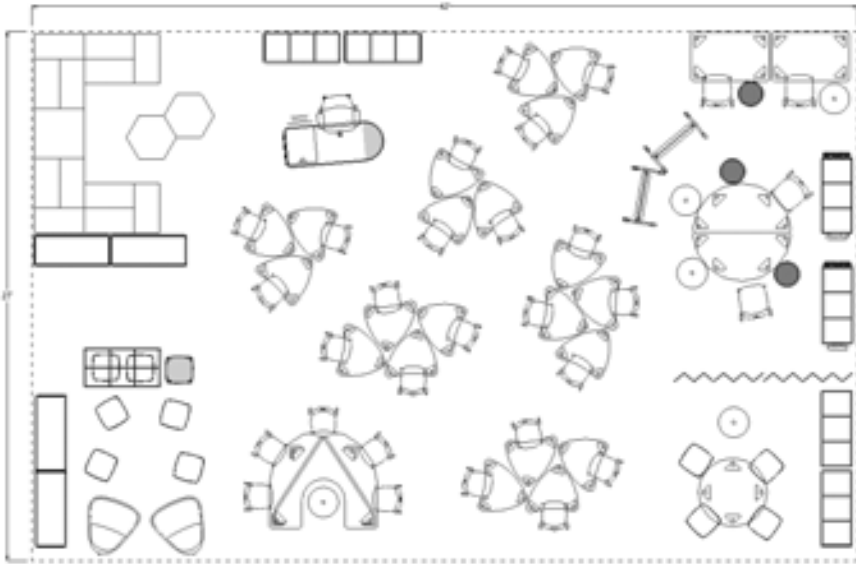

Environmental Considerations:

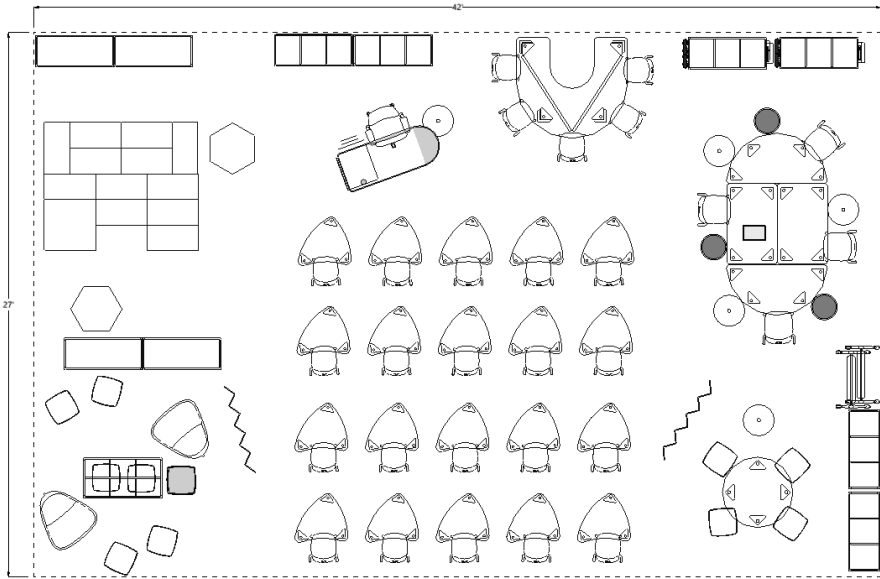

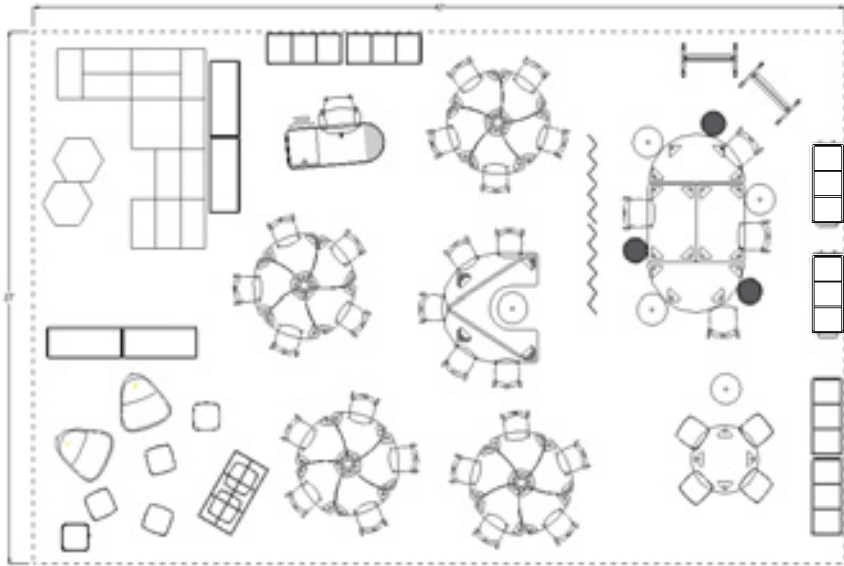
